Matching Pairs

Instructions

- 1. Cut out the Matching Pairs pictures and place them face down on the floor or table.
- 2. Each player takes it in turns to choose two pictures. If they are a pair, the player keeps them and takes another turn. If the two pictures are not a pair, the player replaces the pictures and play moves on to the next player.
- 3. Play continues until all pairs have been found.
- 4. The winner is the player with the most Matching Pairs.
- 5. There are eight pictures without a pair, these food items are not wanted by North Lakes Foodbank as they are either perishable goods, out-of-date, alcohol or sugar. Discuss with the children why North Lakes Foodbank do not want these items.
