

Matching Pairs

Instructions

1. Cut out the Matching Pairs pictures and place them face down on the floor or table.
2. Each player takes it in turns to choose two pictures. If they are a pair, the player keeps them and takes another turn. If the two pictures are not a pair, the player replaces the pictures and play moves on to the next player.
3. Play continues until all pairs have been found.
4. The winner is the player with the most Matching Pairs.
5. There are eight pictures without a pair, these food items are not wanted by North Lakes Foodbank as they are either perishable goods, out-of-date, alcohol or sugar. Discuss with the children why North Lakes Foodbank do not want these items.
